PECS is a series of international biennial conferences on the *Physics of Estuaries and Coastal Seas*. The objectives of the conferences are:

- to promote exchange of information on recent developments in physics of estuaries and coastal seas;
- to stimulate cooperation between coastal engineers and coastal oceanographers, and
- to provide a forum for junior scientists and engineers where they feel comfortable presenting and testing their ideas.

Emphasis is on the results of field and laboratory measurements, and theoretical and numerical analysis, with the aim of better understanding the underlying physical processes. The topic for PECS 2008 in Liverpool, "*Process studies in the pre-operational era*", serves as a guide for presentations and discussions.
